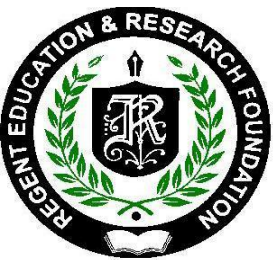

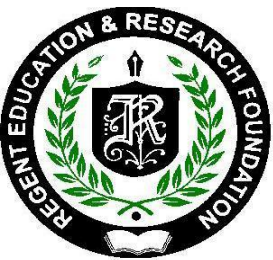

- The premises should not be less than 20 X 30 feet.
- Adequate air and ventilation in the camp premises.
- The area should have been cleaned with disinfectant.
- Minimum of one plug point for the use of Blood Bank equipment.
- Drinking water facility.

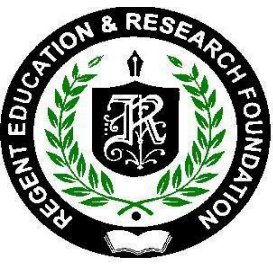
