

"Tech Talk": A talk on future technologies

Rules and Guidelines

1. Eligibility:

- a. The event is open to all the students participating in **NIRMITI 2024**.
- b. Participants must register in advance to secure a spot.

2. Topic selection:

- a. Participants should focus on presenting recent and lesser-known futuristic technologies that are not widely known. The content should be engaging, informative, and suitable for a general audience.
- b. The event coordinators must approve topics to avoid duplication and ensure relevance.

3. Time Allocation:

- a. Each participant will be allotted 5 minutes for their presentation.
- b. There will be a Q&A session of a maximum of 2 minutes following each presentation.

4. Presentation Guidelines:

- a. Visual aids (ppt) are mandatory.
- b. A maximum of 10 slides is allowed for each presentation.
- c. Participants should use simple language and avoid excessive jargon. Participants should explain technical terms or concepts in a straightforward manner to make them accessible to all attendees.
- d. The content of the presentation must be original and not plagiarised. Participants should present their own words.

e. Participants must be available to present on the scheduled event date and time which will be notified later.

5. Selection Process:

- a. Participants have to register their names through the link <u>https://forms.gle/mr9ahg7Ex1Ty7Dc8A</u> by 5th September 2024 and submit their presentation through the link <u>https://forms.gle/vTXsfEM4nvpvFer79</u> by 15th September **2024**.
- b. The registered students will go through a screening process, the details of which will be shared with the participants via mobile or email. After screening, 10 participants will be chosen for the final presentation. Here, the decision of the Judges will be final.

6. Code of conduct:

- a. All participants and attendees are expected to conduct themselves professionally throughout the event.
- b. The event should be inclusive and respectful of all participants. Discrimination or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.
- c. Participants must agree to abide by the event's rules and regulations as outlined by the organisers.
- d. Any participant found violating the rules may be disqualified from the event.





- e. Any issues or concerns, including harassment or technical difficulties, should be reported to the event organisers immediately.
- **7.** Prizes and Recognition:

- a. Prizes should be awarded for the best presentation and certificates will also be presented.
- b. In all these cases, the Judges' decision will be final.
